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Hi all,

I just installed the Google Friend Connect module and Rating/Reviews mambot. Google Friend Connect was placed in position "user1", which is located in the right-side menu area along side the Joomla login box.

The Rating/Reviews mambot does not have a setting (that I can find) for position. So, currently it appears in the same position on the right-side menu area.

Is there a way to separate these modules, so that the Review/Ratings appear at the bottom of the page?

Also, I added a comment to a single page, but that comment appears on all pages where the Rating/Reviews mambot displays. How do I separate the comments so that each page contains it's own comment and ratings list?

Should there be a link back to the main page, or is this an oversight in the plug-in?

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hi-

this plugin basically autoloading google friend connect script for every content on your Joomla website.

yes, as for now, only have 2 choices:

1. you have to install Joomla mod to accompany the plugin (so user can sign up/sign in via the mod). hopefully in future release from google, they will put sign in /up button on top of the comment/rating window

2. click on maximize button link (blue colour) to max the window and you can sign in from there
